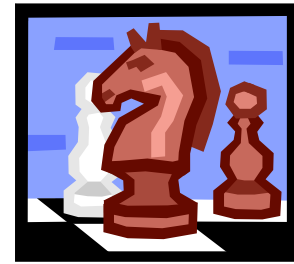

There will be five rounds at 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:30 p.m., 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. The tournament will be a Swiss System, meaning all players play all rounds. At noon, there will be a short break for lunch but not time to leave the campus. A variety of food will be available at a snack bar throughout the day, or you may bring a sack lunch.

Participants may register for 1 of 4 sections:

K-2nd: Anyone through 2nd grade may enter this section

K-4th: Anyone through 4th grade may enter this section

K-8th: Anyone through 8th grade may enter this section

Open: Anyone may register for the Open section, including adults.

If not enough players are in a section, sections may be combined.

The time controls are game/25, meaning each player has a maximum of 25 minutes for their game. Clocks are permitted. If a game is unfinished at the 40 minute mark, then a clock may be placed on the game at the discretion of the tournament director to keep things on schedule.

No talking by players during matches. Parents can quietly observe players from a distance. The tournament is free and non-rated, meaning no USCF membership is required. Trophies and certificates awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers. Pre-registration preferred.
